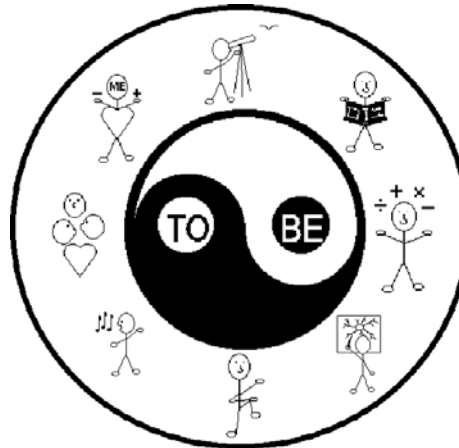
HOW does she work?
